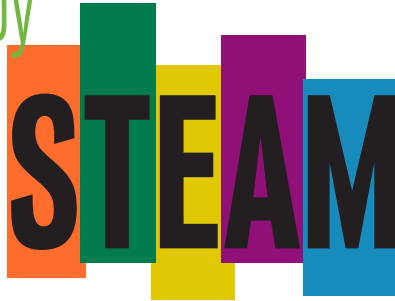

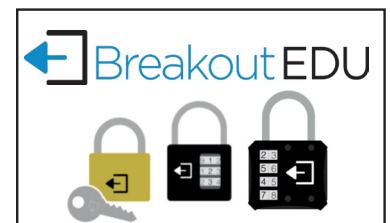

- **Breakout EDU:** Campers will use teamwork and critical thinking to solve a series of challenging puzzles in order to open locked boxes. Can you figure out the clues? Will your team break out in time?
- **Coding:** Campers will use a variety of basic level coding programs to maneuver drones through a variety of challenging mazes.
- **MakerSpace:** Students will bring creativity to life as they create circuits, personal video games, code, and more during a hands-on MakerSpace
- **3D Printing:** Using CADD software students will design and build with 3D printing.
- **Stem Challenges:** Using principles of STEM, students will apply them to a variety of challenges including roller coasters and catapults.
